

# 13. Physical activity breaks (with music in the background)

After activities that require students' concentration, they can clear their minds by doing some simple physical activities:

- Put your hands up and reach for the sky.
- Hold for 5 seconds.
- Put your hands up and bend to the left/right.
- Interlace your fingers and stretch your arms up.
- Hop on your left/right foot.
- Stand on your toes and stretch up high.
- Do (five squats).
- Stoop/Bend down and touch your toes.
- Jog/March in place.
- Do jumping jacks.
- Spin your head.
- Move your shoulders up and down.
- Take a deep breath and let it out.
- Hold your arms straight to the sides and make (five) arm circles forward/backward.
